
News & Notes from Academy Ridge at Landis Lakes

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Improvements....Old & New



The past two years have seen a number of improvement projects to enhance the look and safety of our neighborhood. And there's more to come.....

Previous Improvements include:

- * New speed limit signs and slow down for children signs posted throughout the subdivision.
- * All light poles were repainted and new LED light bulbs replaced older, costlier light bulbs.
- * A new website was developed and the REACH alert system implemented for faster communication.
- * New landscaping at the main entrance to Academy Ridge, replaced non functioning sprinkler system.

Coming in 2024.....

- New signage for the west entrance to the subdivision.
- The lighting at the entrance on South English Station will be addressed to see what we need to do to get those lights up and running. In past years, we have dealt with vandalism to the system. Part of this project will include placing cameras in order to capture the individual(s) responsible for the theft and vandalism.
- Flock Safety System—we are currently waiting on permits from Metro, once those have been received, they will install these theft-deterrent system/cameras at all three entrances. This system will capture the license plate of every vehicle entering and exiting our subdivision as a deterrent for criminal activity.
- The Board will be meeting with the landscape company to discuss trimming the trees at both entrances.
 We also want to add some more landscaping including flowers this spring.
